We're a sanctuary in the heart of Maricopa, Arizona, but as a network, we serve wherever needed. While we're not a therapy center, we've crafted a space that offers teens strength and skill-based avenues to find healing on their terms.

We aim to ease trauma stress and enhance the well-being and growth of teens affected by domestic violence.
